To be eligible, applicant must:

- Be a member at the time of application (if you are not, ask us how to become a member!)
- Be a high-school senior/GED
- Plan on continuing their education at one of the following:
 - o 2 or 4 year accredited educational institution
 - o Technical/Vocational school
- Submit the following:
 - o Complete the included application
 - o A copy of your academic transcript
 - o One letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or employer
 - o 250-word essay
 - o A detailed list of extracurricular/community and/or volunteer activities.

For the essay portion, in 250 words, answer the following:
