To be eligible, the applicant must:

 - o Technical/Vocational school
- Submit the following:
 - o Complete the included application
 - o A copy of your academic transcript
 - o One letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or employer
 - o 250-word essay
 - o A detailed list of extracurricular/community and/or volunteer activities.

For the essay portion, in 250 words, answer **one** of the following;

- What are your short-term and long-term academic and career goals?
- What community service activity have you been involved in, and how have they impacted you?
